


WRITING TASK 1

The pie charts show the destination of export goods in three countries in 2010. Summarise the information by selecting and reporting the main features and make comparisons wherever relevant.

You should not copy phrases from the question. "The destination of export goods" is directly copied from the question. The name of the countries should be written after "...countries in Latin America".

While Europe and other Latin America

While Europe and other Latin America can be referred to as group of countries, the USA and 'others' category cannot be brought under this category. USA is one country. So this is an error.

Change "goods exporting destinations" to "destinations of export" as the earlier version is incorrect.

USA is part of North America together with Canada and this is one continent. Chile, Mexico and Argentina are part of South America together with Brazil and others. This is a different continent. So, when you say "...goods were exported within the continent", it is incorrect. Also, the factual presentation of data is incorrect. For example, you have said that most goods were exported within the continent is factually incorrect.

You have compare things in a random manner and there is no overall progressions.

There is nothing like American continent. There is North America and South America.



Give reasons for your answer and include any relevant examples from your own Knowledge or experience. You should write at least 250 words.



Overall, there are too many grammatical mistakes which makes it extremely hard to understand your essay. Therefore, you get 6.0 in GRA. In the entire essay your opinion is not clear whether this trend has more advantages or disadvantages. This negatively affects the score in TR and CC.

This essay will discuss both side....Instead of this sentence, you should write an outline sentence. For example, Although being under surveillance has some advantages like increased security against theft and robber, I believe that it has more serious drawbacks like breach of privacy.

This was you can give a brief outline about your essay and also express your opinion.

The beginning of this paragraph is not appropriate. The question is not about use of data but about monitoring people with cellphone tracking and security cameras. When you generally mention data it can refer to anything and expands the scope of your argument and disrupts the flow of your essay. Thereby costing you marks in CC and TR. The second example of tracking personal health is not relevant to this task. The question is about surveillance.

In this paragraph, you have mentioned about laws to protect privacy of people. However, this paragraph is about disadvantages of surveillance. So it would make more sense if you first discuss disadvantages of surveillance and then mention the laws.

The conclusion is not at all clear and focusses on data not surveillance.

Word Count – around 450 words. Too long. Keep it between 270-300 words
