Commented [A4]: embark is not used like this. Although it means to make a start but it is frequently used with journey. to embark on a journey of lifetime. It is never used to refer beginning of a letter or idea.

Commented [A6]: you simply rephrase to add the information in the same sentence. ...our meeting held a fortnight ago while flying from Mumbai to Delhi in SpiceJet Airlines.

Commented [A14]: Don't write this. You are expected to be honest while applying for a job.

Commented [A15]: You are not adding any new information but only explaining your skills as a chef. So the use of this cohesive device is inappropriate.

It seems to me that you have learned words but you do not really understand their usage. Using complex vocabulary inappropriately will negatively impact your score in LR. If you are not sure of the meaning/ usage, please do not use a fancy word.

You have a tendency to write multiple sentences conveying the same meaning. Please do not do this as it negatively impacts your coherence and cohesion and task achievement.

One of your main body paragraphs, where you mention which position you are interested in, falls weak on task achievement.

WRITING TASK 2

You should spend about 40 minutes on this task.
