I am Gokulraj. In the last report as well it was pointed out that you should not introduce yourself like this. Your name is written at the bottom so this is not required and looks really weird.

convey gratitude – Better to use “appreciate”. I am writing to tell you how much I appreciated/ loved your performance.

Furthermore does not fit here. What you are saying is an extension of the previous sentence so furthermore is not suitable here.

In addition is wrongly used. You are an independent musician and your album got viral which was based on breakups. This is one topic. You are taking a course is not in addition to the theme of the music album. It is a different topic and not in addition to the previous one. Also, note that cohesive devices are not always required to improve you're the flow. If you overuse them, they will actually disrupt the flow. You can often connect sentences

differently. E.g. I am a musician and perform with my university friends and one of my album got viral last summer. It was based on different emotions that one feels after a breakup. Now, to further improve my singing, I am taking a course.....

Why do you separate independent sentence by commas? This was also pointed in the last report. Please go through the feedback carefully and try not to repeat the same mistakes. Only then, you will be able to improve your score.

Can you assist me? The tone of this sentence is inappropriate. You are asking for a favour so please be polite and say, “Could you please....”

If you are busy, do not hesitate to respond. What does this mean? Nothing, right! You intend to say that if you are busy then you can say no to my request.

This essay discusses the reasons behind... The question has not asked you to discuss reasons of working long hours. You only have to discuss advantages and disadvantages and give your opinion on whether advantages outweigh disadvantages.

In MBP 1, you mainly discuss the reasons behind why people work long hours. This not relevant to the topic.

The example of coder suffering from a spinal cord injury in future is an over-exaggeration. You are saying that if someone codes all day, it will definitely lead to spinal injury. Such examples are marked negatively, so please them. You could have said, "sitting in front of a computer all day may lead to back problems or spinal cord ailments later in life". Here we are only giving a possibility so that is fine.

In MBP-2, you say that people tend to be friends with someone who has higher social status. You also say that people who work long hours have better social status. This means people who over work have more friends. But, in the conclusion you say that if a person works extra hours, he/she will be left alone. This is a contradiction of what you said in the previous paragraph. Not good for the conclusion and will decrease your
